<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In general, educating children already is easier and much more sustainable than trying to change adult behaviour. Aiming to teach children in Kindergarten already is important to make them aware adults and is therefore one important element. • However, the professionals performing the training (Kindergarten teachers, teachers during vocational education) have to have the competence and the means to do so. In that way, all players in the digitally changing (working) world need to be fit for education. • A third important consideration is the shape of training and the willingness to learn of the (professional) adult. It is a challenge to overcome (established) routines, especially if the cancer risk is not directly visible for the eye and one does not learn about the cancer from the already retired colleague. Closely related to Awareness Raising, the RoC management will screen Education initiatives that are used also in different settings and for different risks of society to screen for successful and beneficial educational tools.
